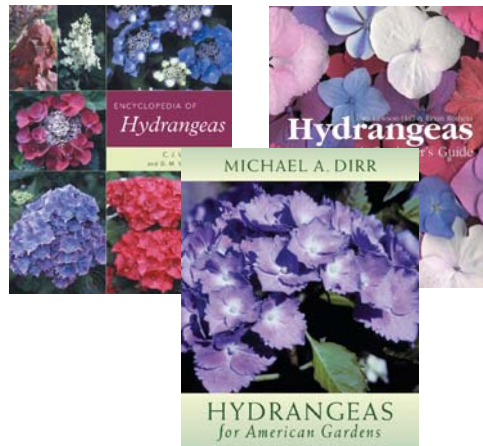


Where To Get More Information About Hydrangeas

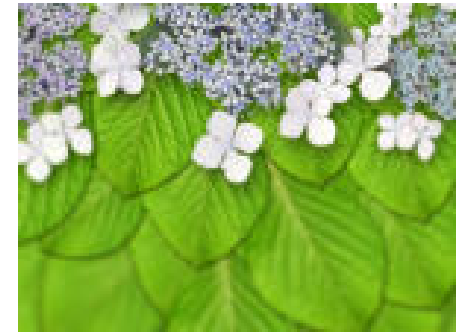
